CHAPTER 110: GENERAL LICENSING PROVISIONS

Section

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§ 110.01 LICENSE REQUIRED.

It is unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to engage in any activity for which a license is required without first obtaining such license, as herein provided. The City Commissioners may at any time expand the general provisions of this title by requiring any person, persons, firm or corporation engaging in any trade, business, occupation or activity within the city which is not specified by this title to obtain a license, as deemed necessary. (Prior Code, § 5.04.010) Penalty, see § 10.99

§ 110.02 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE.

Any person, persons, firm or corporation wishing to obtain a license as herein provided, shall make written application to City Manager stating the name of the applicant, address, purpose of the activity, the length of time for which the license is wanted, and the particular place at which the license is to be used. Fees for all licenses shall be fixed by the City Commissioners where not specified in this title and all license fees shall be paid in full at the time of application in such manner as approved by the City Commissioners. (Prior Code, § 5.04.020)

§ 110.03 LICENSE EXPIRATION.

All annual licenses granted under the provisions of this chapter shall expire on the December 31 following the granting thereof, except as otherwise provided, and shall not be granted for any sum less than the annual rate, and there shall be no rebate made on the termination of the calling, vocation or kind of business for which the license was issued. (Prior Code, § 5.04.030)

§ 110.04 DISCRIMINATION.

All licensees shall conduct their business so as not to discriminate against any person because of race, color, sex, creed, religion, ancestry, national origin, familial status or disability. (Prior Code, § 5.04.035)

§ 110.05 LICENSE REVOCATION.

The City Manager has the authority at any time to suspend or revoke any license granted under the provision of this title whenever the City Commissioners shall be satisfied upon written complaint that such calling, vocation or kind of business for which the license was issued is in violation of the city ordinance, rule or regulation, or state law.

§ 110.06 ISSUANCE.

Except as otherwise provided, all licenses shall be issued by the City Manager and the applicant shall have complied with all requirements for issuance of such license. Unless otherwise provided, all licenses shall be signed by the City Manager and shall have affixed thereto the official seal of the city. (Prior Code, § 5.04.050)

§ 110.07 RECORD OF LICENSES.

The City Manager shall keep a record of all licenses issued by the City Commissioners stating when and to whom issued, for what purpose and for what length of time, the amount of money paid for the license, and the place where such activity is to be carried on. (Prior Code, § 5.04.060)
